Your good self please note that vide Circular Nos. **LIST/COMP/10/2019-20** and **LIST/COMP/12/2019- 20** dated 9th May, 2019 and 14th May 2019, respectively has clarified that the above stated compliance of submission of Annual Secretarial Compliance Report is not applicable to Listed Entities which have claimed exemption under Regulation 15(2) of SEBI (LODR), 2015.

In this regard, we respectfully submit that, as **our Company falls under the criteria as specified under Regulation 15(2) of the SEBI (LODR) Regulation, 2015 due to the fact that the Paid-up Equity Share Capital and Net Worth of the Company was below Rs. 10 crores and 25 crores respectively as on the previous Financial Year end date i.e. 31st March, 2023 the company was therefore not required to comply with the provisions of Regulation 24(A) of SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2018 and SEBI Circular No CIR/CFD/CMD1/27/2019 dated 8th February, 2019 and thus not required to submit Annual Secretarial Compliance Report.**

Opinion
